Subject: European Directive 2011/65/EU (RoHS 2)

As of the date above Flint Hills Resources, LP (FHR) polypropylene products comply with 2011/65/EU and/or amendments.

Flint Hills Resources does not intentionally add heavy metals (lead, mercury, cadmium, or hexavalent chromium), polybrominated biphenyls (PBB's), polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE's) or phthalates (DEHP, BBP, DBP, or DIBP) to any of our polypropylene products.

Testing has indicated that some of our polypropylene products may contain trace catalyst residues (<8 ppm) of Dibutyl phthalate, Diisobutyl phthalate, and/or Bis (2-ethylhexyl) phthalate. Benzyl butyl phthalate was below the detection limit of the instrument used to test.

Please note that we have not specifically tested for all of these substances in our product(s) and supplier product information has not been verified by testing. Our determination regarding this directive is based on supplier information and knowledge of the production processes for these products. FHR strongly recommends that each customer and/or end-user independently determine the suitability of FHR product(s) under actual conditions of processing and end-use. Ultimately, customers must make their own determination that use of this product is safe, lawful, and technically suitable for their intended applications.
